Onsite accommodation is available for all students attending scheduled STAR Center courses. Our check in desk is located 100 yards west of the main 4-story building on West Dixie at: 900 SW 2nd Avenue Dania Beach, FL 33004 Tel: (954) 921 7254 Ext. 7999																			
It is manned 24/7, except on Thanksgiving, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. Check-in is after 3pm the day prior to class start. Departure is to be no later than 10:00am the day after course completion unless express permission has been obtained prior to arrival.																			
All rooms are single occupancy with ensuite facilities. Sorry, pets are not allowed.																			
The cost for non-sponsored guests is \$135 per night plus all applicable taxes (currently 6% Florida Sales Tax applied to Room & Board and 5% Broward County Room Tax (\$148.25 total)). This fee includes full galley access, which includes 3 cooked meals daily Monday to Friday and self-help at all other times, 24/7.																			
Eligible AMO members/applicants, their spouse and certain immediate family members are accommodated at no charge from the day prior to scheduled training until the day after training completes. Other authorized guests or attendees may be accommodated for a facilities fee of \$32 per person per day , plus 6% Florida Sales Tax, when sharing the same accommodation unit.																			
AMO members and their family/guests are welcome to arrive early or stay after their completes if space permits. However, in accordance with Department of Labor requirements, all additional nights must be charged at the appropriate rate (currently \$148.25 per night plus \$33.92 per additional guest aged 12 years and older accompanying the registered student (includes spouse/significant other).
